Footwear

Thank you for your support with our new footwear policy. Of the 870 students at Paulet, only 30 arrived to school in the wrong footwear and most of them have already put it right.

Perimeter Fence

As I begin my sixth year as Headteacher at Paulet, I have finally managed to secure the funding for a much needed perimeter fence for our sports field. Starting in early October, the fence will be erected from the yard to the bridleway and then along the length of the field. It will secure our field and prevent members of the public trespassing, seemingly at will, with their dogs. Every morning our caretakers do a field check and regularly find 'dog deposits'.

School expansion

I am sure some of you will have seen, in the local paper, that plans are in place to expand our school by two forms of entry. This has been a proposal for a number of years and it is now becoming a reality with the building and associated outdoor spaces to be complete within three to four years...more news to follow!

The John Taylor MAT


