Year 11 GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20th August 2020

GCSE results day will continue as originally planned on Thursday 20th August 2020. This is the only day available for students in Year 11 to physically come and collect their GCSE results. If students are unavailable at the given time slot below, then the results will be emailed to them using their Paulet email account.

Paulet followed a robust grading and ranking process to award centre assessment grades for each student in each subject they were due to sit. Exam boards will standardise these based upon the prior attainment of students and the past performance of the school in each subject. Please understand that at the time of writing this letter and due to the current situation, explicit guidelines and measures put in place by the school must be adhered to during the day by all students and family members.

Students have been allocated a time slot for the collection of their results. These are outlined below:

When arriving on site, we ask that students enter through the yard entrance and walk towards the atrium. Weather permitting, the collection of results will take place in the open air, however, in the unfortunate event of inclement weather, the atrium will be set up for students to collect their results.

All students are permitted to bring one family member with them if they choose to. Once the results are collected, we require students and family members to exit through reception. Should any students require support, we will have a number of spaces available on the day for meetings to take place.

Applicants to the Paulet Sixth Form will receive written confirmation of their final Sixth Form offer on GCSE results day. This enclosed letter will detail further instructions and important dates for enrolment.

Further details regarding the start of term arrangements will be on the website and all social media platforms. We also implore that students regularly check their Paulet email accounts.
