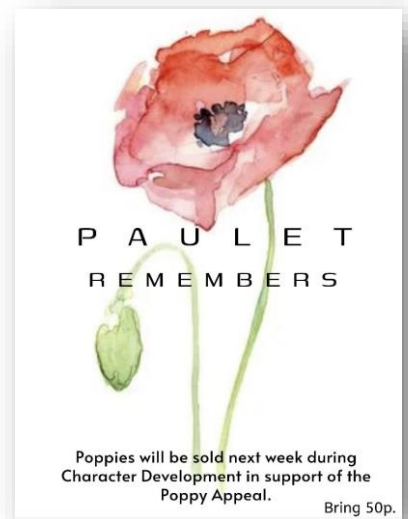


Friday 4th November 2022
