As I wrote in my last letter, we are going to embrace Comic Relief Day this year. Mrs Deer has met the Student Council today (Thursday) to start to plan; details to follow.

Student Council Updates

I have met with the Student Council a few times this year and we have agreed the following:

- We have ordered two additional table tennis tables for the yard
- We have ordered additional benches for the Atrium for Y7/8 seating
- The lesson change over bells will be turned off in the 6^{th} form block but remain on in the corridors – if you are a parent of a 6^{th} Form student you will understand this
- Fitting air quality sensors in the toilets to detect if a vape is being used...

We have a small number of students who have used vapes in the toilets; obviously this is unacceptable. These sensors will help us to eradicate this as the overwhelming majority of our students don't like this behaviour. Students found with a vape in school will be given one of a range of sanctions including fixed term suspensions. This BBC article, Experts warn over vaping packaging - BBC News, is an interesting starting point for parents keen to learn more about 'vapes' including the information that, in 2015, it became illegal to sell any vaping device to children under the age of 18.

Toilet Passes

I have become increasingly concerned about the number of students who have a toilet pass and 'need' to go to the toilet multiple times during the day. A letter has already gone out to parents saying that, from Monday, 6th March, only students whose parents have supplied medical evidence will be given a new look toilet pass which will be signed by members of staff so parents can see how many times their child goes to the toilet during lesson time. We need to minimise toilet visits as each one is lost learning. There are five opportunities to go to the toilet during the day – for students and staff. Obviously, students who have a 'personal emergency' will be allowed to go during a lesson.
