Welcome to the new school year.

We are looking forward to welcoming your child(ren) back for the new school year! I am writing today with some important information about the return to school next week and some key dates.

Phased return to school

We welcome our new Year 7 students next Tuesday 5th September for their first day. They should arrive onto the school yard in good time for the 8.27am bell which signifies the start of the day. Please ensure they are in their correct Paulet uniform with a school bag and writing equipment – they should start as they mean to go on. PE kit is not required on this day.

All other students return on Wednesday 6th September - equipped and ready and in the correct school uniform.

We expect that all students to be in full school uniform including school shoes which comply with our uniform policy available on our website: Policies and Procedures – Paulet High School & 6th Form College

A gentle reminder that all shoes must be plain black leather or leather look and be able to be polished. We DO NOT accept trainers or canvas shoes.

Equipment

Your child must bring to school every day:

- A rigid plastic or aluminium reusable water bottle
- A student planner planners will be given out on the first day back.
- A pencil case equipped with a black or blue pen plus spares, pencil, rubber, ruler.
- An appropriate school bag.


