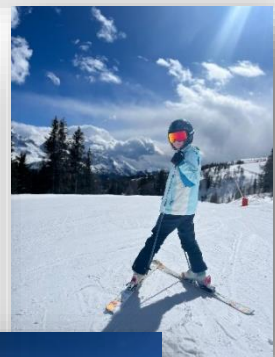
Updates and messages from Mr McArthur and this week at Paulet

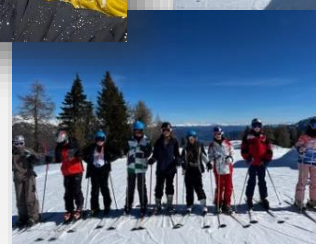


Skiing Trip 2024
