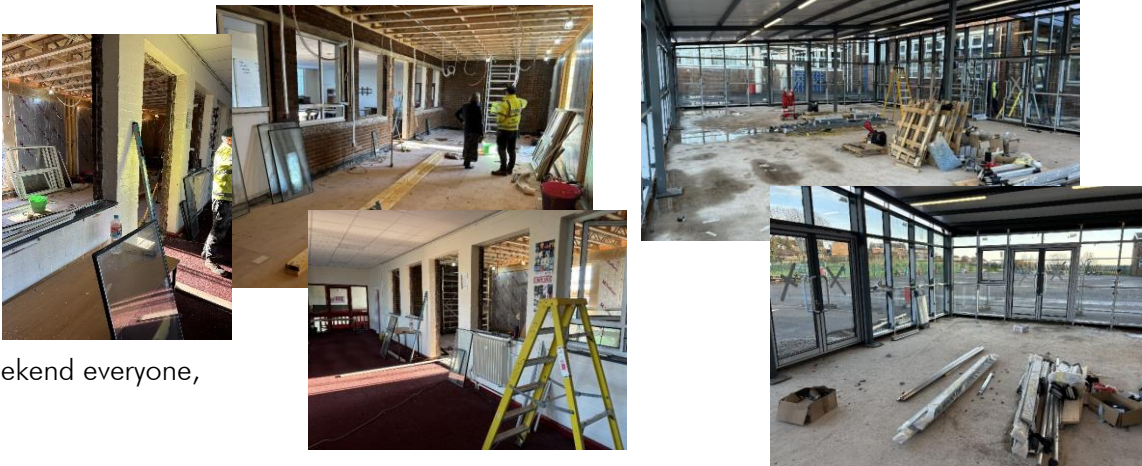
This week at Paulet:

This is a good time to remind everyone about arrangements for the end of term. This year we are finishing for our Christmas Holiday on Thursday 19th December, and we reopen at **9.30am on Monday 6th January 2025.** The end of term looks like this:

- Wednesday 18th December – Christmas Jumper day and food collection for our local food bank – appropriate clothes for school please with a festive twist.
