A group of Paulet students had the opportunity to visit to the National Memorial Arboretum on Wednesday with Mr Goodall. They partook in a series of workshops highlighting the contribution of black members of the British armed forces from World War One to present to commemorate Black History Month. They were privileged to hear life stories from two veterans in person and also explored a range of memorials and found out about some of the lives of people they commemorate. As part of this they also visited the Polish Forces Memorial to focus on the contributions made by the Polish nation to the allied cause in World War Two. We also visited some memorials that commemorate the contribution of local people from Staffordshire during both world wars and beyond.
